The threshold (minimum mark) for $B$ is set halfway between those for Grades $A$ and $C$. The threshold (minimum mark) for $D$ is set halfway between those for Grades $C$ and $E$. The threshold (minimum mark) for $G$ is set as many marks below the $F$ threshold as the E threshold is above it. Grade $\mathrm{A}^{*}$ does not exist at the level of an individual component.
