




(a) Draw to a scale of 1 : 2 the development (net) of the card packaging.




Use corner **A** as your starting point.

(b) Complete the sketches to the right to show how the flaps should be folded so that they lock together. [4]




Section B

The outline of the postcard is shown below.


- (a) Divide accurately the long side of the postcard into three equal parts so that, when folded, the postcard will have three faces as shown in the pictorial view. [3]

 - (ii) the costs of downloading 1, 5 or 20 tunes. [3]




